WeGovNow The WeGovernment Platform

WeGovNow develops and validates a digital platform for effectively engaging local civil society in the co-production of citizen-centred services and in the co-development of strategic approaches to community development.

The WeGovNow Platform is a multifunctional community engagement platform composed of pre-existing civic engagement applications which have been integrated with newly developed software components. It includes five functionalities that allow people to:

- report local problems;
- vote for local policy action;
- network with citizens;
- create & share information on themed local maps;
- match offerings & demand for collaboration & support.

- San Donà di Piave (IT)
- London Borough of Southwark (UK)
